We Can Help

Our mental health services create lasting change for children facing immense challenges from early abuse, trauma, and neglect. We help parents build the skills to support emotional and behavioral growth and often break cycles of trauma that span generations. Our programs have helped children avoid school expulsion, stay in loving foster homes, and heal from deep emotional wounds.

Our developmental services provide vital support for significant delays in intellectual, physical, and emotional growth. We help parents nurture development, from enhancing language and motor skills to fostering social and emotional growth. These services prepare children for school success and empower parents to advocate for their needs.

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WE CARE'S MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES



- **Parent-Child Therapy:** In-home or in-office therapy for children facing trauma, loss, depression, anxiety, or aggression.



- **Wraparound Program:** Family-driven, team-based care offering advocacy, peer support, and coordination.



- **Behavioral Support Services:** In-home or community-based coaching to help caregivers understand and respond to behaviors.



- **Intensive Care Coordination:** Team-based mental health and care planning for children with significant needs.



- **Preschool Consultation Program:** Support for teachers, families, and preschools to address behavioral challenges and prevent expulsion.



- **PATH: Perinatal Attachment Therapy:** Therapy for expectant mothers to support bonding and mental wellness.

- **Everyday Moments:** Community-based guidance to help caregivers turn daily routines into developmental opportunities.

- **Early Connections:** A 24-week program offering bonding and parenting support for new caregivers.

- **Thrive: Parents as Teachers:** A home-visiting program offering parenting support, child development tools, and resources.

WE CARE'S DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES



- **Beyond Boundaries Toddler Program:** Early intervention for toddlers with or at risk for autism using relationship-based, routine-focused teaching.



- **Developmental Playgroups:** Specialist-led groups supporting children with delays through play-based learning and parent involvement.



- **Preschool Classrooms:** Inclusive classrooms promoting school readiness through developmental, social, and emotional support.

- **Home-Based Infant Development Services:** Weekly visits supporting infant development and strengthening the parent-child bond through individualized early intervention.
