Our caring and supportive teaching staff provides an educational and enjoyable environment designed to help instill a love of learning in preschoolers, focusing on:

- Creative, fun activities to develop pre-academic skills
- Positive social skills, emotional development, independence, responsibility
- Readiness for kindergarten, which leads to preparation for elementary school

Classes meet Monday to Friday for 3 hours a day and are available to income-eligible families.
